Mr. Plyler appeared to represent the request. He explained he would like to extend his garage 20 foot to accommodate more car space. Dr. Essin built the existing garage in the early 50's, it was a wood carport and Mr. Plyler has added garage doors. He would like to construct the carport/garage with brick columns, cedar, composition shingles and renovate the existing garage to look the same. He would like to eventually brick the structure, put in a floor, and enclose the sides. The columns will be decorative.
