CALL TO ORDER

APPROVE MINUTES

REPORT ON PARKS AND RECREATION ACTIVITIES

Mrs. Hutchinson announced that the Candy Cane Hunt is scheduled for Saturday, December 13th at Pecan Grove West from 1:00-3:00 pm. The annual event will include hunting for candy canes, photos with Santa and crafts. The Father Daughter Dance will be on January 31st in the Municipal Ballroom.

REPORT ON PARKS AND RECREATION SPORTS

Mr. Hubert reported the SYSA and TSA leagues have finished their seasons. The adult volleyball league had 7 teams and it finished this week. The Taylor St. Complex is being used for Pickleball and Shooting Stars Special Olympic basketball. The basketball games are on Saturday mornings. Piner students will be using the Taylor St. Complex for practice and Parks & Recreation will be using the Piner gym for their adult basketball league. Mr. Winkler announced that the long term goal is to have a full-time staff position at the Taylor St. Complex to allow for more activities.

REPORT ON PARKS MAINTENANCE

Mr. Mrozinski reported that the Park Maintenance department is trimming trees and planting. Mr. Mrozinski, Mr. Hubert, and Mr. Brown will be attending a sports turf training seminar in Ft. Worth on December 16, 17, and 18th. Mr. Mrozinski announced that Mr. Stephens had put in his two week notice.

REPORT ON SENIOR CENTER

Mrs. Howard reported that the Senior Center would be offering a Self Defense class on December 11th at 5:00 and the class is free. On December 15th, the S&S choir will be performing. December 16th will be the Santa Wrapping party and TAAPS will provide a bus for the seniors to go see the lights at Loy Lake. The New Year's Eve party will be at noon on December 31st.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Winkler announced that Mr. Bibb put in his two week notice and his last day was November 26th. Mrs. Hutchinson passed out the pool numbers for the year. The cost recovery was better this year and the Learn to Swim numbers were higher. Mrs. Hutchinson reported that the Toys for Tots program has 72 families sign up so far to receive toys. Applications will be taken until December 12th and toys will be distributed on December 15-17. The Parks & Recreation Department has part-time positions available. The part-time staff would cover the front desk and help cover recreational activities.
