CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Trent Bass called the meeting to order at 12:35pm with a quorum present.

APPROVE MINUTES

Chairman Trent Bass asked if there were any corrections, additions, or deletions to the minutes of June 11, 2015. There were no corrections.

ACTION TAKEN

Motion by Member John Murphy to approve minutes as written; second by Member Brian Jones. All voted aye.

REPORT ON PARKS AND RECREATION ACTIVITIES

Mrs. Hutchinson announced that the Pickleball tournament held on June 27th had a good turnout. Three teams from the metroplex participated. Wendy Miller organized the tournament. Mrs. Hutchinson reported that Lights on the Lake was on July 2nd with about 7500 people in the park. Roughrider tickets for the game on July 24th are being sold now for \$20 each.

REPORT ON PARKS AND RECREATION SPORTS

Mr. Reeves announced that the 8u state softball tournament was coming up the week of July 12th. Sunday will be the coach's meeting and opening ceremonies. There will be 18 teams participating and games will begin on Monday, July 13th. The championship game will be played on Thursday. There will be a gate fee and not outside food and drinks allowed in the facility. Mr. Reeves reported that the adult summer softball leagues have started. The Men's league is on Tuesday's and the Co-Ed is on Thursday's.

REPORT ON PARKS MAINTENANCE

Mr. Mrozinski reported that the park maintenance department is busy getting caught up on mowing. Staff is working on Saturday's and will change their schedule to come in earlier for the summer months. Mr. Mrozinski announced that they have been treating for mosquitoes and that the pier at Pecan Grove Park had to be re-set. Now that Lights on the Lake is over they will be preparing for the

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state tournament. Mr. Mrozinski reported that they are looking to do some work on OSP fields 6 and 7 to help with the drainage.

REPORT ON SENIOR CENTER

Mrs. Howard announced that they had a cookout with seniors and they had about 71 participants. Some upcoming events at the Senior Center will be an ice cream social, a music show, belly dancing performers, and a Sock Hop at the ballroom on August 7th.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Mrozinski announced that he had a meeting next week with Mr. Ayers, Mr. Winkler and Mr. Blackwell to see if he could use a temp agency to help find seasonal workers for Park Maintenance. The department only has 9 and they need to have between 12-14 seasonal workers. Mr. Mrozinski said they are trying to raise the seasonal pay rate to see if that would help.

Chairman Trent Bass announced that he had gone to a trail meeting and was going to meet with Mr. Ayers to give him his past trail notes.
