Mayor Wacker said that during the Budget Work Sessions this summer, the City Council agreed that they would review a number of fees and fines related to services that are provided by the City. Many of these fees have not been adjusted in years and need to be reviewed to keep them in line with the current cost of providing the services. Sherman's fees generally fall at or below average for cities the size of Sherman, and really for all cities in Texas.

Mayor Wacker added that, in order to provide the level of service that the citizens expect, these adjustments must be made to stay in line with rising costs.

Robby Hefton, Assistant City Manager/CFO, said this is the annual "housekeeping" item where actual expenses are "trued up" with the budget.

The developer has agreed to pay for the portion of the Loy Lake Road/Hwy 75 Bridge Project, beyond the bridge. The City will pay the Texas Department of Transportation but the developer will pay the City so the net effect will be zero to the City.

There are some other “clean-up” items in other funds. These have been discussed during budget work sessions.

Council Member Johnson asked how much of the \$1.5 million will be paid by the developer. Mr. Hefton said \$1.3 million will be paid by the developer and \$200,000 is a refund from TxDOT on a 2011 ramp reversal project south of F.M. 1417, which cost less than expected. The refund was passed back to the Sherman Economic Development Corporation because they originally paid for the project.

Mayor Wacker said both projects represent progress for Sherman’s transportation mobility needs.
